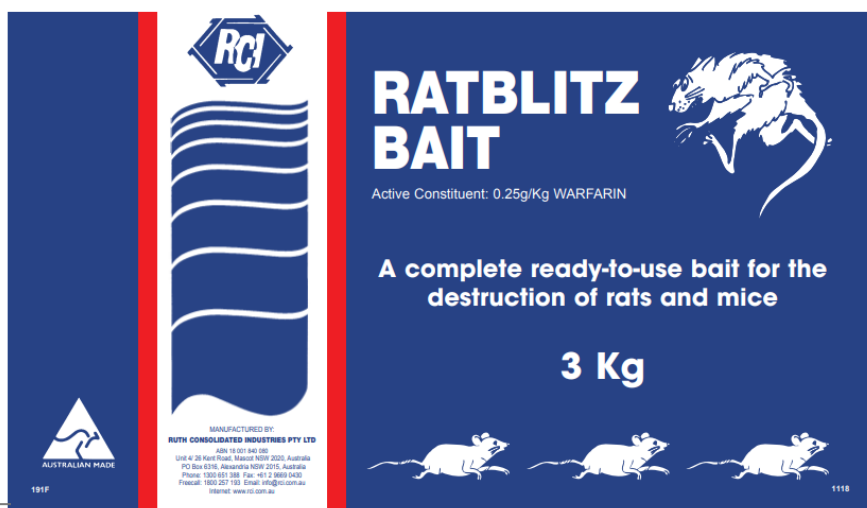

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Restraints

DO NOT exceed 3m between baits for mice, or 9m for rats.

DO NOT place baits in open.

DO NOT prepare or use baits where there is a risk of contaminating foods, animal foods or drinking and washing water.

Situation	Pest	Rate	Critical Comment
Domestic, industrial, wharf areas, around farm buildings, dairies and meatworks (non-product areas).	Rats and mice.	100g of baits per rat bait site. 50g of baits per mice bait site. Approximately 3-4 baits per site.	Place baits in areas of known rodent activity. Follow the baiting strategy detailed below.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Baiting Strategy Eliminate as far as practicable, all alternative food sources. Bait infested area. Place baits under cover in lots of 50g for mice and 100g for rats. Inspect baits daily. Replace eaten baits. If eaten quickly increase number of baits. Continue observation and replenishments until no more baits are taken. Baiting for at least two weeks is necessary to reduce rat/mouse numbers.

PRECAUTION Must not be used in areas accessible to children.

PROTECTION OF LIVESTOCK AND THE ENVIRONMENT Place baits in locations inaccessible to other animals and birds. This product is hazardous to pigs, cats, dogs and poultry. DO NOT contaminate ponds, waterways or drains with the product or used containers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL Store in the closed, original container in a dry cool well-ventilated area, out of direct sunlight, away from children, animals, food, feedstuffs, seeds and fertilisers. Break, crush, puncture and bury empty containers and dispose of unused bait in a local authority landfill. If not available, bury containers and unused bait below 500 mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt. Dispose of carcasses safely by burning or burying in an approved landfill.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS Poisonous if swallowed. Do not inhale dust. Do not touch the bait. Use scoop or measure. If on skin and after each baiting, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Wash hands after use.

FIRST AID If poisoning occurs get to a doctor or hospital quickly. (Phone: 131126)

Vitamin K1 (phytomenadione) is antidotal.
